Improved Instructions To Help Guests Enter TBGCC

We continually strive to make sure accurate information is disseminated to the community and we have determined recently there may be confusion operating the 4-digit kiosk. Below are updated and *improved* instructions that will help those who continue to have issues getting their visitors entered to the community.

NEW Instructions On How To Use The 4-Digit Code When Your Visitor Is At The 4-Digit Kiosk

If the guest knows the 4-digit code, key in ONLY the 4 digit code, DO NOT PRESS CALL. Once your phone rings, answer the call; you can speak to the guest and then **PRESS 99** on your phone. *Once the phone disconnects (the call automatically ends), the gate should open.*

If the guest does NOT know the 4-digit code, the guest will scroll to your name. Once the name is highlighted, the guest will then press **CALL**. Once your phone rings, answer the call; you can speak to the guest and then **PRESS 99** on your phone. *Once the phone disconnects (the call automatically ends), the gate should open.*

The phone number that will show up on your caller ID is **352-206-2323**; it's recommended that you add this number to your Contacts so you know how to answer the call.

The Benefits Of Issuing An EPass To Guests

Key points:

- Your guest is automatically on your guest list so even if the ePass is not used, the gate attendant can easily find your guest's name on your list.
- The ePass can be scanned at any time during the dates of the issued ePass.

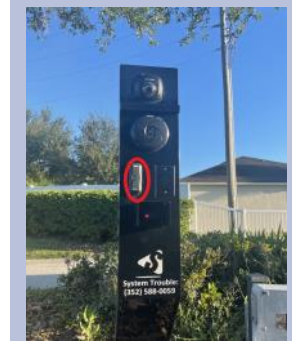
Using Your Amenity Badge At Front & Back Gate Kiosks

You can use your amenity ID badge at the kiosk at the front or back gate when the gate attendant is not present. For example, if you are returning to the community in a car that doesn't have a windshield tag on it, simply place your badge on the rectangular plate.

Active House Guest passes can also be used to access the community when the gate attendant is not present.

COMMUNITY REMINDERS

Our Streets Are Our Sidewalks

One of our most beloved amenities is our beautiful golf course and how it weaves throughout the community. On many of the holes, golf carts must navigate our roads.



This is a reminder to all pedestrians, automobile drivers, bicyclists and golfers to be keenly aware of your surroundings. Our streets are our sidewalks,

and we must each do our part to prevent accidents.

PLEASE NOTE: Golfers must obey all traffic signs, coming to a complete stop at stop signs and, when traveling between tees, from cart path to road.

Walkers should walk *facing* traffic, bicyclists should ride *with* traffic and automobile drivers should strictly adhere to posted speed limits (25mph on Old Tampa Bay Drive and 15mph on all other TBGCC roads).

Golf Course Cart Paths

The golf course cart paths are for **GOLF USE ONLY**. Please do not use the cart paths for walking, bike riding or non-golf cart rides through the course.

NOTE: The golf course is still open after the pro shop is closed. This means it is possible that we have golfers on the course at all times.

13.7.1. Golf carts shall not be used by a Member or guest on the property of the Club without proper assignment and registration in the pro shop.

13.7.17. Golf carts shall be driven on the golf course only when it is open for play.

13.8.13. Private carts without payment of appropriate fees will not be allowed access to the golf course.

13.8.15. Privately owned golf carts shall be driven on the golf course only when the golf course is open for play.

Guest Passes, Owner/Resident Membership Access Card

Friendly reminder: When guests visit and want to use the amenities, members can accompany them or secure House Guest Passes.

If you can't accompany your guest, the Unit Owner—not the guest—must complete the Guest Pass Request form **in advance**, either by picking up a form at the Clubhouse or by submitting an e-form via the website, www.tampabgcc.com. Make sure you log in, then click on LIFESTYLE, then FORMS, HOUSE GUEST PASSES.

Please remember that giving a guest your membership card to use the amenities violates Rules & Regulations 6.1 Membership, 6.1.7 Membership Card.

Alligator Mating Season Begins In April; Do Not Feed

We are in alligator mating season again. Alligators tend to move about at dusk and during the night while hunting for food, and during mating season in April and May. During the month of June, Mama Gator is protecting her nest.

Their diet depends on availability, and they will eat anything up to and including other gators, as well as waterfowl, small mammals, and yes, children, dogs, and cats.

Here at Tampa Bay Golf and Country Club, we encourage parents, grandparents, and pet owners to stay well away from any water's edge while walking pets or minding small children, especially at and after twilight.

Alligators can easily lunge half their body length onto shore and are also capable of moving swiftly on land for short distances—up to 35 mph for very short bursts, according to the Florida Parks and Wildlife Department.

Please remember it's illegal to engage an alligator in any way in the state of Florida, and that includes feeding. An alligator that has been fed loses any natural fear of humans, and then



views people as a potential food source; a dangerous combination of factors.

Do not throw food into the water; although you may not intentionally be trying to feed alligators, the result can be the same. If you notice some alligator traps around the retention ponds, it is because an alligator has been seen and reported.

Please remember this was their home before it was ours; they will always be part of our community and are extremely helpful to our ecosystem.

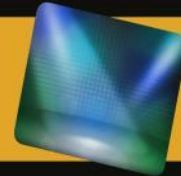

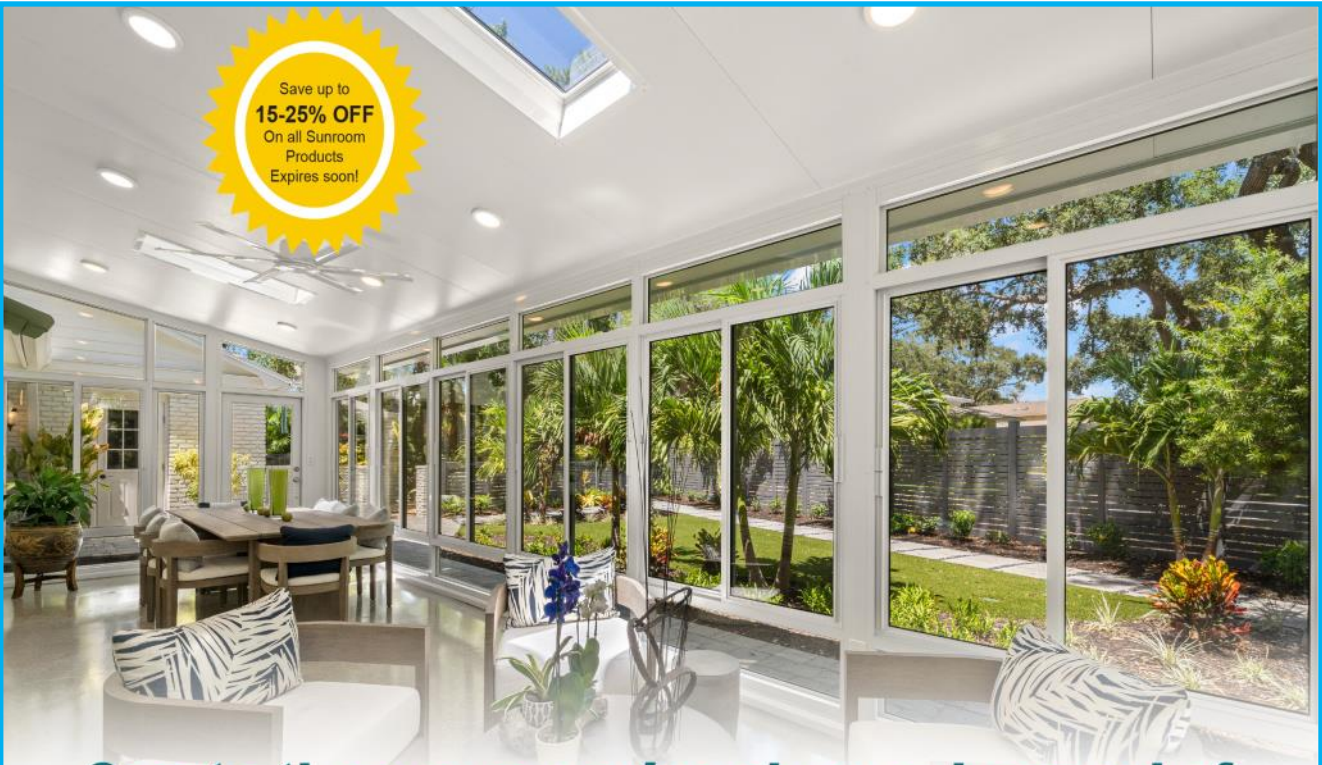

Our Story

Founded in 1890, GFWC's roots can be traced back to 1868 when Jane Cunningham Croly, a professional journalist, attempted to attend a dinner at an all-male press club honoring British novelist Charles Dickens. Croly was denied admittance based upon her gender, and in response, formed a woman's club—Soros. In celebration of Sorosis' 21st anniversary in 1889, Jane Croly invited women's clubs throughout the United States to pursue the cause of federation by attending a convention in New York City. On April 24, 1890, 63 clubs officially formed the General Federation of Women's Clubs by ratifying the GFWC constitution. Since 1890, GFWC's impact has been felt throughout communities across the United States and the globe.

Our speaker for this celebration was one of our own! We honored our history with a very special speech from one of our original members, Nancy Schrader. She has been a volunteer with the GFWC TampaBay Woman's Club for 5 years and is our resident photographer, making sure our memories are captured.

GARDENING CLUB

Proper Watering Necessary As Gardening Season Begins

As April begins we also come to the very dry season in Florida. Please remember that your plants, shrubs and grass need water—all need at least 1 inch of water per week. To check, set a container in one or several beds or the grass. Run your sprinklers for a known time and then measure the amount of water in the container. If less than one inch, adjust the time on your sprinkler to get to around one inch of water.

Since Pasco County has a ban on watering more than one day a week, set your sprinklers so you can get 1 inch



during the time your irrigation is operating.

Time To Trim

Now is also the time to trim your shrubs. Never cut more than half the length of the main branch during this trim.

After trimming, fertilize your plants using a granular 6-6-6 fertilizer, a time release fertilizer such as Osmocote or Dynamite, or a liquid fertilizer such as Miracle Grow bloom booster or 20-20-20.

Read the instructions on the package as to the amount of fertilizer to use—either how many square feet an application covers or how to water the fertilizer in, but in any case do not overuse the amount of fertilizer spread on the area.

Time To Transplant

Annual flowers and vegetables should now be planted if not already done. You can always go to a big box store or a nursery to get plants that have been started earlier in the season that you can transplant now. Dig a hole twice as large as the potted plant you are putting in the ground and add peat moss and/or compost, if you have it, to the hole to enrich the soil for the plantings.

Water these plants and make sure your irrigation system is working in the area of the plantings at a rate of 1 inch per week. The growing and harvest season is now well on its way in Florida, so enjoy the beautiful flowers and the fresh vegetables that will be coming from your garden.

Move Indoor Plants Outside

Finally, give your indoor plants a break. Take them outdoors and let them stay out for the season if you have plants that can stand the outdoor conditions you have.

Remember to water them at the same one inch per week if your plants require the water. If they don't require that amount, read up on how much water your particular plants need.

The Garden Club meets the third Tuesday of each month at Noon in the Clubhouse Small Cardroom with either speaker programs or field trips scheduled.

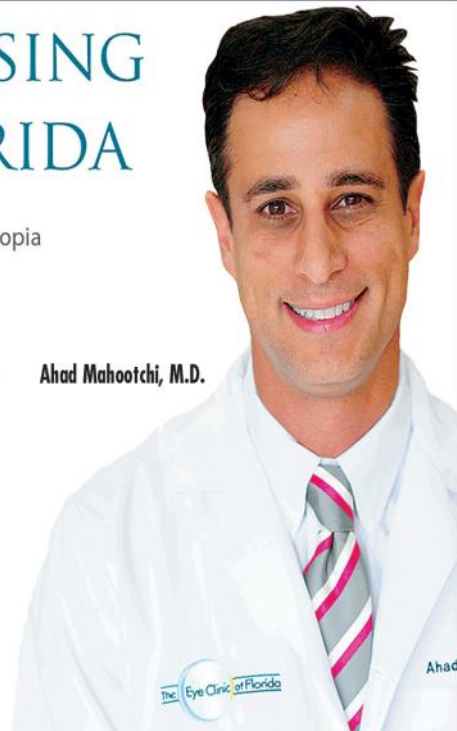
