Having Trouble Receiving Community Group Emails?

If you have recently stopped receiving our community emails and your email address has not changed, you may need to check your email settings. Confirm with me that your email address is correct by either sending an email to wdarby@tbgcc.org or calling 352-588-4642.

Once I have confirmed your email address on file is correct, you will need to access your emails from your email provider's website. **You must have your email password available to log in directly from the provider website.**

Below are a few of the most popular providers and their email login websites:

- Yahoo mail—mail.yahoo.com
- Gmail—accounts.google.com
- MSN mail—outlook.live.com
- Hotmail—outlook.live.com
- Roadrunner—webmail.spectrum.net

Do a complete email search using the words “tbhappenings” or “TB Happenings.” Sometimes, a more general search, such as using just “happenings,” may be necessary if the original search doesn’t yield results.

IF the search results show the emails, look where they are being sent: Junk/spam folder, Promotions folder, etc. *Note: Each email provider (gmail, yahoo, msn) may have unique default folder names but ALL of them have a junk/spam folder and that is where 99 percent of lost TBCA community emails end up.*

If the emails have been located, this indicates you are receiving them; it’s your email provider who is not recognizing you WANT those emails filtered to your INBOX. Now, you must communicate to your provider that our email address (tbhappenings@gmail.com) is a SAFE SENDER and the Tampa Bay website (tampabgcc.com) is a SAFE DOMAIN.

These are examples of some email provider login pages, including from top, clockwise, Outlook, Spectrum, AOL, Google and Yahoo!

Open the email SETTINGS to make the change. Each email provider’s settings are located in different areas and can seem complicated. A quick internet search should be helpful but if you would like assistance, please call or email me to schedule a time to change the settings together.

I’ve assisted many residents in changing this setting with excellent effective results. I get asked why this happens; while I don’t have the exact answer, it most likely has to do with email providers frequently updating their security. So, although it can be very annoying, it is a proactive measure they take to help protect their customers. Fortunately, updating this setting is usually a one-time change.

COMMUNITY REMINDERS

Our Streets Are Our Sidewalks

One of our most beloved amenities is our beautiful golf course and how it weaves throughout the community. On many of the holes, golf carts must navigate our roads. Our streets are our sidewalks, and we must each do our part to prevent accidents.



This is a reminder to all golf cart drivers, bicyclists, pedestrians and auto drivers to be keenly aware of your surroundings.

PLEASE NOTE:

GOLF CART DRIVERS must obey all traffic signs, coming to a complete stop at stop signs and, when traveling between tees, from cart path to road.

BICYCLISTS: Please ride *with* traffic and be aware of approaching automobiles. For safety, helpful side mirrors may be installed on your bicycle handle.

PEDESTRIANS: Please be sure that you walk facing oncoming traffic. This is very important as it allows you

to see what is happening, in front of you, at all times. This will allow you to react if something goes wrong with oncoming traffic. Please do this every time.

AUTO DRIVERS: Please be aware of the importance of honoring the 25mph speed limit on our main road and 15mph on parcel roads and be extra careful driving, knowing many of your fellow residents are walking or riding on our roads.

Cart Paths For Golf Use Only

The golf course cart paths are for **GOLF USE ONLY**. Please do not use the cart paths for walking, bike riding or non-golf cart rides through the course.

NOTE: The golf course is still open after the golf shop is closed. This means it is possible that we have golfers on the course at all times.

13.7.1. Golf carts shall not be used by a Member or guest on the property of the Club without proper assignment and registration in the pro shop.

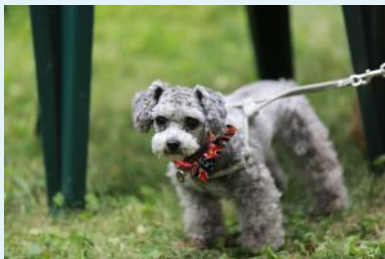
13.7.17. Golf carts shall be driven on the golf course only when it is open for play.

13.8.13. Private carts without payment of appropriate fees will not be allowed access to the golf course.

13.8.15. Privately owned golf carts shall be driven on the golf course only when the golf course is open for play.

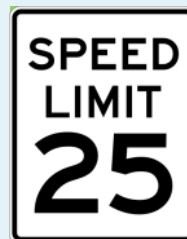

Alligator Mating Season Goes Through May; In June, Mama Protects Nest

We are in alligator mating season again. Alligators tend to move about at dusk and during the night while hunting for food, and during mating season in April and May. During the month of June, Mama Gator is protecting her nest.

Their diet depends on availability, and they will eat anything up to and including other gators, as well as waterfowl, small mammals, and yes, children, dogs, and cats.

Here at Tampa Bay Golf and Country Club, we encourage parents, grandparents, and pet owners to stay well away from any water's edge while walking pets or minding small children, especially at and after twilight.

Alligators can easily lunge half their body length onto shore and are also capable of moving swiftly on land for short distances—up to 35 mph for very short bursts, according to the Florida Parks and Wildlife Department.

Please remember it's illegal to engage an alligator in any way in the state of Florida, and that includes feeding. An alligator



that has been fed loses any natural fear of humans, and then views people as a potential food source; a dangerous combination of factors.

Do not throw food into the water; although you may not intentionally be trying to feed alligators, the result can be the same. If you notice some alligator traps around the retention ponds, it is because an alligator has been seen and reported.

Please remember this was their home before it was ours; they will always be part of our community and are extremely helpful to our ecosystem.

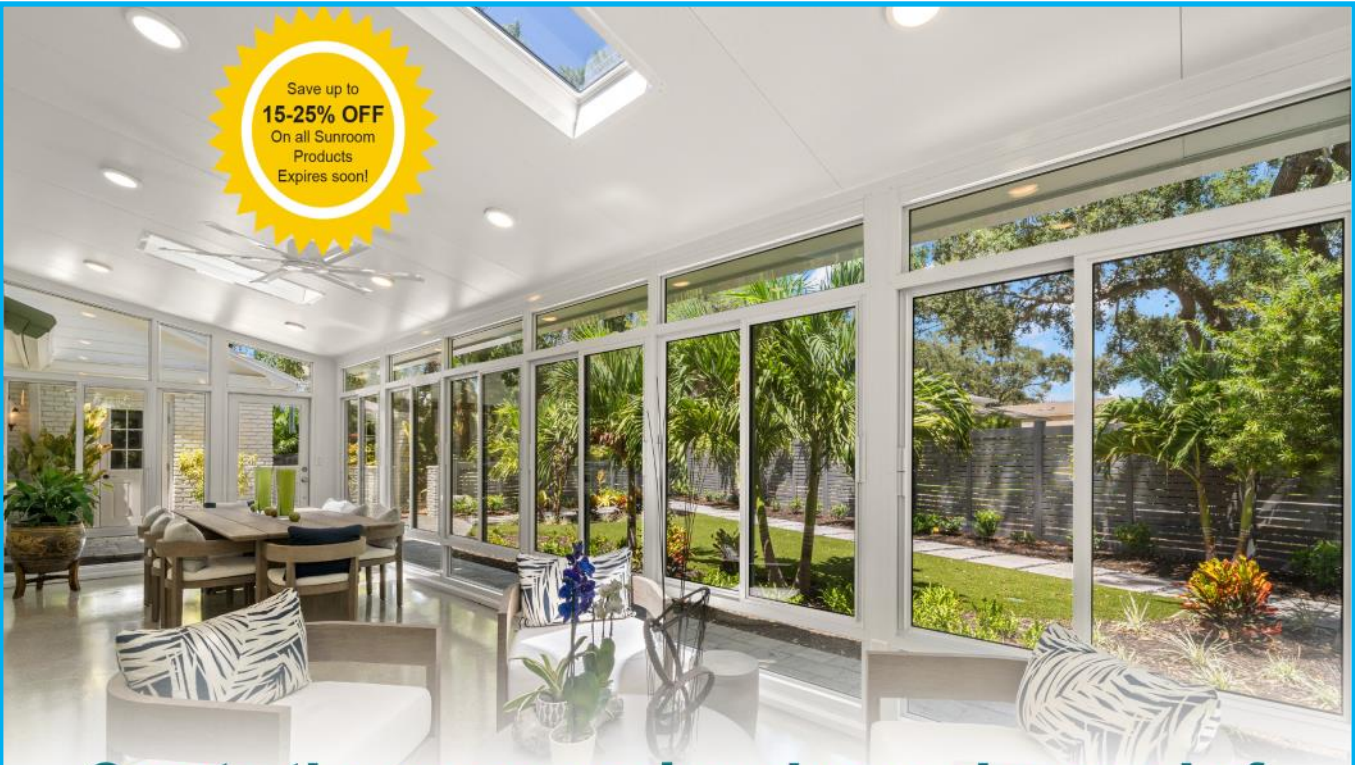

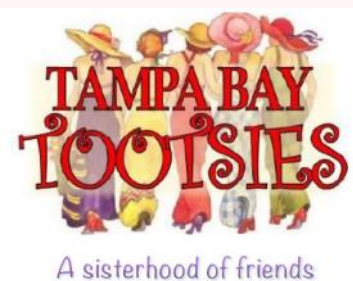

Consider Adding Less Troublesome Trees

From the poem, “There is nothing as lovely as a tree,” comes truth, but even the loveliest of trees may cause problems. Following are some local problem trees, followed by some suggestions for alternatives.

Magnolias

The Southern Magnolia has beautiful flowers, is stately, looks great but this broad leaf evergreen isn’t totally evergreen all the time. In spring, many leaves turn yellow

and drop. Then appear beautiful flowers that eventually fall and have to be cleaned up. Next the seed pods come and then dry out: The large red seeds show themselves, finally dropping to the ground, also needing to be picked up.

However, this isn’t the only problem as magnolias are very susceptible to scale: the small white insect that eats the leaves and turns them a combination of white, yellow, green and colors in between and then they drop to the ground. Yes, there are insecticides that kill the scale but as the tree grows, it becomes almost impossible to spray the tree. It is a beautiful but there are and will be problems if you have one or more in your landscape.

Oaks

Another problem tree is our stately oak, be it live oak, pin oak, Shumard oak, red oak, laurel oak or any other type of oak that grows well in the south—all have tap roots and side shoots that can plug sewers, drain lines, underground lines. They also can tangle with underground utilities and lift sidewalks, roads, driveways and almost anything they can get under.

In our area, you almost every year see oak leaf blister in the spring, depending on the weather being cool and wet. It can become an epidemic at times and infect most of, if not all, its leaves and on surrounding oaks. The leaves turn brown, yellow, and various colors of light green and fall from the oak. But this disease, as the scale, seldom gives permanent damage to the tree.

Alternative Trees

Alternatives to these trees are some that are just as beautiful but a lot less trouble: trees of the holly family such as the Nelly Stevens, Savannah or East Palatka hollies, the Japanese blueberry, the Tea Olive, the Redbud and some of the tree forms of shrubs. These trees are easy to shape, one can easily control their size, and don’t shed the pollen of some of the larger trees while still meeting all TBGCC and Pasco County’s tree requirements.

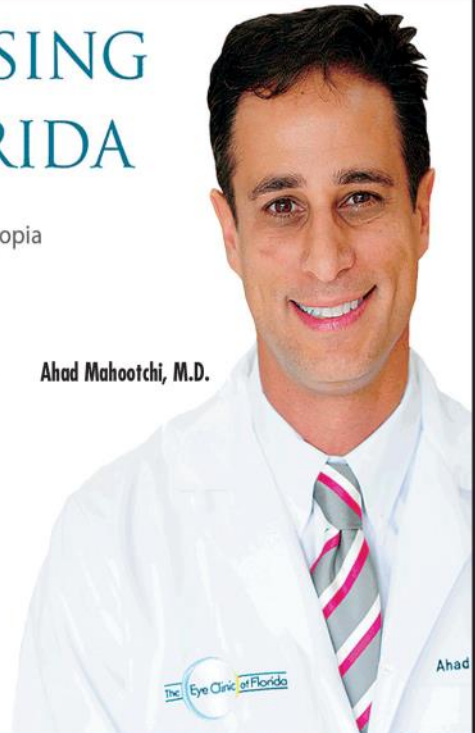

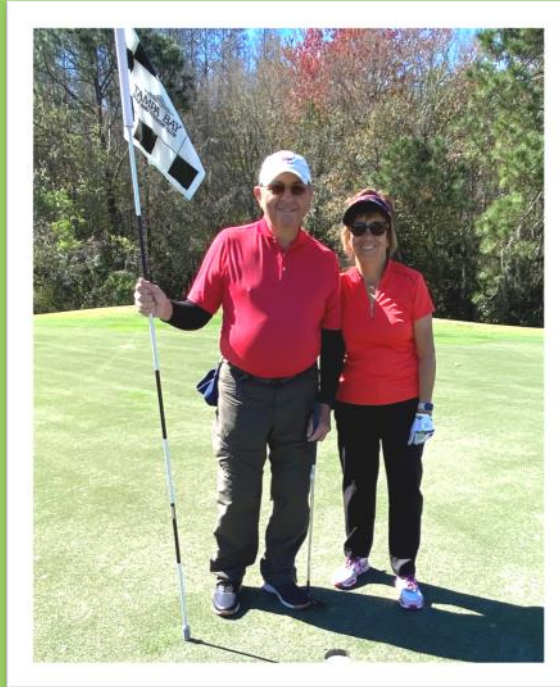
